- 1. The Centre for Mathematics, Science and Technology Education in Africa (CEMASTEA) hereinafter referred as "Procuring entity" intends to prequalify candidates for the supply of goods, works and services for the years 2023 2025
- 2. Prequalification is open to all eligible applicants as per the eligibility criteria.

- 4. Candidates will only qualify by meeting the set criteria to perform the contract of supply of goods and services to the Center. Suppliers fail to meet the prequalification criteria will not be allowed to participate in the RFQs/RFPs of the same category.

SECTION II INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- 2.1 Scope:
- 2.1.1 Centre for Mathematics, Science and Technology Education in Africa (CEMASTEA) hereinafter referred to as the 'procuring entity' intends to prequalify suppliers for the supply of goods, works and services for the year 2023-2025. It is expected that the prequalification applications will be received by the not later than the date on the invitation letter.
- 2.1.2 Prequalification is open to eligible firms as shown in paragraph 2.3 herein below.
- 2.1.3 The contract will be a unit price contract where bidders will be invited to quote for items as and when the procuring entity deem necessary
- 2.2 Submission of Applications will be not later than Monday 5th June 2023 at 9:00am.
- 2.2.1 Applications for prequalification shall be submitted in sealed envelopes marked with the tender name and tender number and deposited in the Prequalification Box at the Administration block, CEMASTEA, located at the junction of Karen-Bogani Road and be addressed to:

The procuring entity reserves the right to reject late applications.

- 2.2.2 All the information requested for prequalification shall be provided in the English language. Where information is provided in any other language, it shall be accompanied by a translation of its pertinent parts into English language. The translation will govern and will be used for interpreting the information.
- 2.2.3 Failure to provide information that is essential for effective evaluation of the applicant's qualifications and timely clarification or verification of the information supplied may result in the applicant's disqualification.
- 2.3 Eligible Candidates as per the criteria
- 2.3.1 This invitation for prequalification is open to all candidates who are eligible as defined in Kenya's Public Procurement Law and regulations and as indicated in the appendix to instructions to candidates.
- 2.3.2 The procuring entity's employees, committee members, board members and their relative (spouse and children) are not eligible to participate in the tender unless where specially allowed under Section 66 (5) of the PPADA, 2015.
- 2.3.3 All candidates who will be satisfactory in accordance to the set evaluation criteria shall be prequalified.

2.4 Qualification Criteria

2.4.1 Prequalification will be based on meeting the requirements in the criteria set as shown in the appendix to instructions to candidates below. The declaration will be either pass or fail regarding the applicant's general and particular experience, capabilities and financial position as demonstrated by the applicant's response in the forms provided in Section III and submitted with the letter of application. The procuring entity reserves the right to waive minor deviations if they do not materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract.

2.4.2 **General Experience**. The applicant **shall** meet the following minimum criteria

- (a) Provide a copy of Business Registration certificate / Trade license, Certificate of Incorporation/Registration as well as a valid copy of the Tax Compliance Certificate, PIN Certificate and CR12 copy and copies of ID for sole proprietor
- (b) Physical address, email address and contact details.
- 2.4.3 **Specific Experience**: Details of similar assignments recently undertaken including at least **three reference** contacts and detailed client list in the past.

2.4.4 Financial position.

Applicant shall provide their audited accounts (accounts should be audited by accountants/accounting firms officially and currently registered with ICPAK) for the last <u>one</u> year, AGPO Registered firms to provide Bank Statements up to 3 months and a letter of reference from the bank that must demonstrate soundness of the applicant's financial position, showing long-term profitability. Where necessary the procuring entity will make inquiries with the applicant's bankers.

For firms owned by individuals and partnerships the applicant shall demonstrate that he/she has access to, or has available, liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit and other financial means sufficient to meet the cash flow.

2.4.5 Litigation history; the applicant should provide accurate information on any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts completed or under its execution over the last two years. A consistent history of awards against the applicant or any partner of a joint venture may result in failure of the application.

2.5 Public Sector companies

- 2.5.1 Any public owned enterprise may be eligible to qualify if, in addition to meeting all the above requirements, it is also legally and financially autonomous, it operates under commercial law, and it is not a dependent agency of another public entity.
- 2.6 Updating prequalification Information
- 2.6.1 Prequalified candidates shall be required to update the financial information used for prequalification at the time of submitting their bids and to confirm their continued compliance with the criteria. A bid shall be rejected if the applicant's qualification thresholds/ attached evidences are no longer met at the time of bidding.
